

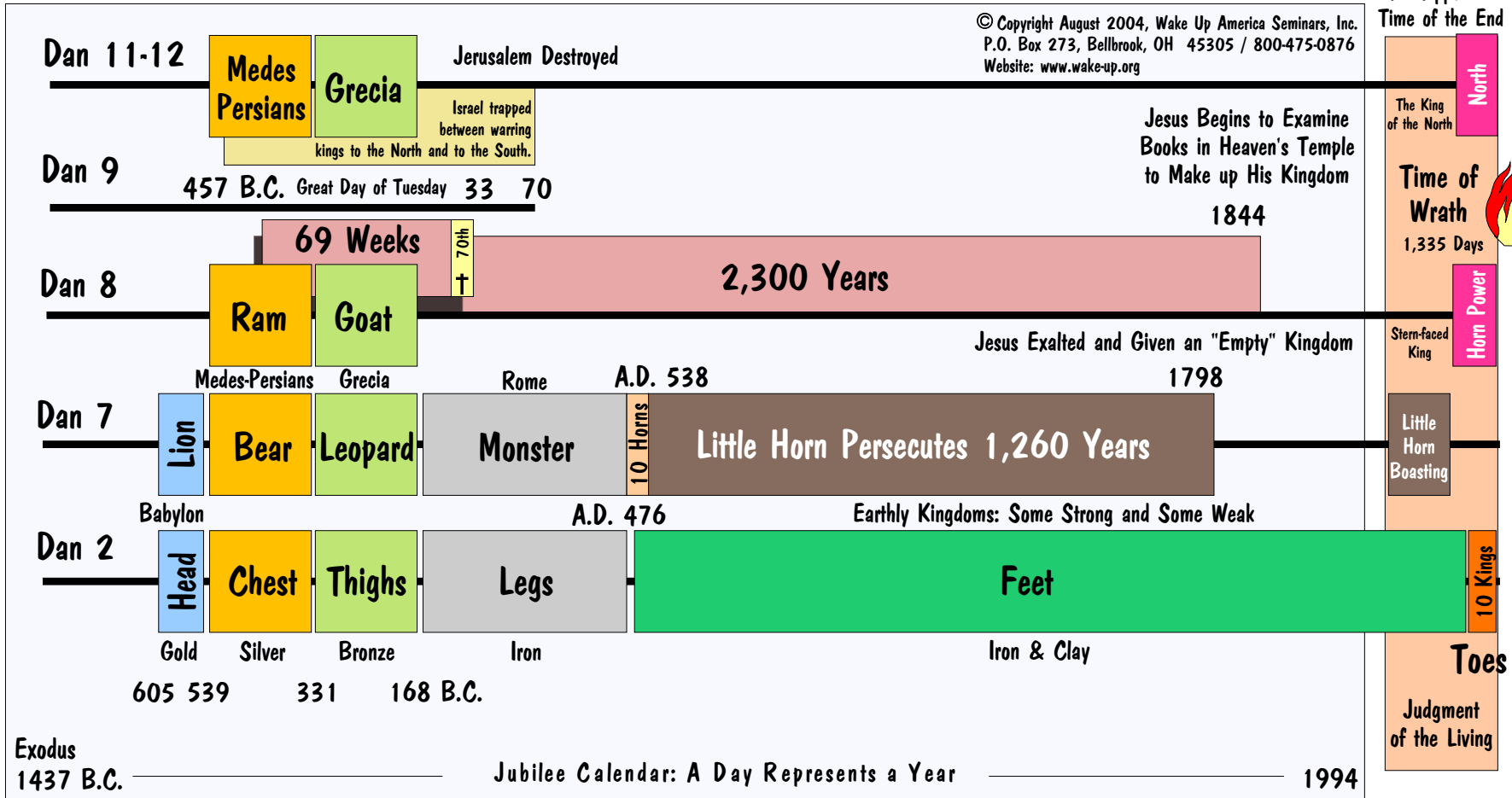

Four Rules of Interpretation

- Rule 1: Each apocalyptic prophecy has a beginning and ending point in time and the events must occur in the order they are given.
- Rule 2: A fulfillment only occurs when all of the specifications of a prophecy are met. This includes the order within the prophecy.
- Rule 3: Apocalyptic language can be literal, analogous or symbolic. To reach the intended meaning, one must consider (a) context, (b) parallel language used elsewhere in the Bible and (c) if symbolic, the element must be defined by a relevant text.
- Rule 4: The presence or absence of the Jubilee Calendar determines how God measures time in apocalyptic prophecy.
